

Punjab Vigilance conducts surprise checking of LPG supply van & register a case against distributor

Chandigarh, April : In order to keep a vigil on prices of essential commodities across the state, Punjab Vigilance Bureau [today](#) conducted joint surprise checking of LPG Supply Van at Ramneek Chowk, Kapurthala and found 17 LPG cylinders underweight.

Disclosing this here [today](#), a spokesperson of Vigilance Bureau said that during the checking, 17 LPG cylinders laden in TATA Ace vehicle were found underweight. The checking team comprised of officers from other departments including Special Executive Magistrate Manpreet Singh Bhoomi, AFSO Kashmir Singh, Inspector Sukhchain Singh and Inspector Inderpreet Singh from Food and Civil Supply Department.

A case No. 93 under section 7EC Act 1955 has been registered against the driver of the vehicle Dula, Helper Lovekush and Owner of Khulani Gas Distributor Vinay Khulani at city Police Station Kapurthala.
