Vigilance nabs ASI for taking bribe of Rs. 5,000

Chandigarh, February 2: State Vigilance Bureau today nabbed a Assistant Sub-Inspector red handed while accepting a bribe of Rs. 5,000.

Disclosing this here today, an official spokesperson of the Vigilance Bureau said Baldev Singh, Assistant Sub-Inspector posted at police station Rampura city, Bathinda district was nabbed red handed by Vigilance team for accepting bribe of Rs. 5,000 from the complainant of Jyoti r/o Gandhi Nagar Rampura Phool, Bathinda district. The complainant has approached the VB and alleged that the above said Assistant Sub-Inspector was demanding Rs. 5,000/- for presenting the record in the local court for anticipatory bail to his father and brother.

After verifying his information, a VB team laid a trap and the accused Assistant Sub-Inspector was arrested on the spot while accepting a bribe of Rs. 5,000/- from the complainant in the presence of two official witnesses.

He informed that a case under Prevention of Corruption Act has been registered against the accused at VB police station Bathinda and further investigation was under progress.
